STUART'S NEWS

As we prepare to say goodbye to 2009 and look towards 2010, I suspect a lot of people reading this (if there are any) may be disheartened with the current position of the Agricultural industry and commodity prices. I personally believe that this industry has a positive mid-term outlook and to back that up I have listed below some extracts from a report containing the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and development (OECD's) 2009-2018 report.

The OECD paints a really bright picture. They say that, *"Agriculture is showing more resilience to the global economic crisis than other industries, falls in agricultural prices are likely to be moderate as long as the economic recovery begins within two to three years."*

For the next ten years, the OECD suggests that, *"Arable crop prices will be 10-20% higher in real terms than in the past ten years. Vegetable oils will be 30% higher, while butter will average 12% more from 2009-2018....."*
"An expected economic recovery, renewed food demand growth from developing countries and emerging biofuel markets are the key drivers underpinning agricultural commodity markets over the medium term"

The report goes on to warn of extreme price volatility similar to the price hike of 2008, as agricultural commodity prices have become increasingly linked to oil and energy costs. For example, if crude oil heads back to \$100/barrel as opposed to the \$70/barrel built into the OECD's 10-year forecasts, then agricultural prices will be significantly higher as crop outputs fall and demand for biofuels increases.

Meanwhile, food production will have to increase 40% by 2030 and 70% by 2050 if the world is going to feed itself. So hopefully we have brighter times to come,
